

# **Research Committee - Terms of Reference**

# **Purpose**

The role of AHCDC Research subcommittee will be to provide strategic direction and leadership in developing supportive mechanisms and a framework to promote collaborative investigator-initiated research/scholarly projects on bleeding disorders in Canada.

# Membership

<u>Chair</u> – The Chair can be self-nominated from one of the existing Research Committee member and selected by consensus recommendation of the members; if no existing member is interested in serving as the chair, we will seek out candidates from the AHCDC membership community.

<u>Members</u> – Members should be current members of AHCDC and have substantial clinical or basic research experience in hemostasis, and/or interest in academic and educational advancement of early-career investigators.

The committee is made up of approximately 6-8 members, ideally balanced between adult and pediatric treaters.

# **Meetings/ Communication**

The members will generally meet by teleconference at the call of the Chair at least twice a year, or more frequent if needed. The Committee will report to the membership through the Executive Committee.

# <u>Costs</u>

Sufficient to hold 2 to 4 teleconferences per year.

Funds to support specific programs under the purview of the research committee (e.g. funding grants/awards, HEALING meetings) will come from AHCDC sources/sponsorship.

# Current committee goals

- Organize, facilitate, and help implement the HEALING program (Hemophilia & Bleeding disorders care Enhancement And Learning Initiative Group)
  - Goal of HEALING is to convene physician members of AHCDC with research interests/projects for an annual in-person brainstorming, feedback and mentorship sessions on their research/scholarly project related to the care and research of patients with bleeding disorders.
- Update members on research funding and scholarly activities (e.g. Hemophilia academy, HTRS, CHS grants etc.)
- Assist AHCDC board with scientific abstract planning, selection and adjudication at AGM
- Re-name and rework implementation of AHCDC funding support for Canadian, investigator-lead research projects (i.e. Change Dragon's Den to something else)
